School Annual Education Report (AER) Cover Letter

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2010-2011 educational progress for the North Huron School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. For 2010-2011, North Huron School made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

1. North Huron School is a single building district consisting of grades K-12. Our students are assigned to our school code of 32080 and building code of 02734.
2. North Huron School has submitted a school improvement plan for the last three (3) years.
3. North Huron School district is one school with no specialized schools within it.
4. To access the core curriculum of North Huron Schools please visit the Michigan Department of Education Office of School Improvement, www.michigan.gov/mde and view the Parent's Guide to each of the Grade Level Content Expectations. These state benchmarks are followed by each teacher and are covered throughout the school year. Grade level and department meetings are held to ensure that the pacing maps of these standards are being met.
5. North Huron School administers the National Normed Achievement Plan test to our sophomore students yearly. On the composite score, 35% of our students fell within the 1-14 range, 26% fell within the 15-16 range, 13% fell within the 17-19 range and 26% were in the 20-32% range.

Last year the PSAT test was given to those sophomores that chose to take it. Twelve sophomore students were given the test. All twelve students met the

requirements for the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) Programs.

Last year the ACT test was given to all juniors. For the graduating class of 2011 our school composite score was 18.9 compared to the state average of 20.0.

6. The number of students represented by parents at the secondary level during parent-teacher conferences was 60% for the fall and 45% at the winter conferences.

The number of students represented by parents at the elementary level during parent-teacher conferences was 92% for the fall and 89% at the winter conferences.

7. At the secondary level the following is reported for Dual Enrollment and AP courses:
 - a) The number and percentage of Dual Enrollment students in the 11th grade was 3 out of 35 for 8.5%. For 12th grade 4 out of 39 students were in Dual Enrollment or 10%.
 - b) No AP/IB classes were offered in the 2010-2011 school year.
 - c) No AP/IB college equivalent courses were offered in the 2010-2011 school year.
 - d) Of the seven (7) students that took Dual Enrollment classes all seven (7) of the students received a score that led to college credit.

Congratulations are in order to all of the fine staff, children, community members and administration of both the elementary and secondary schools. Our goal of one team, one plan, and one goal is helping us to achieve high academic standards. Through our school improvement team we are looking forward to becoming even stronger. While keeping in compliance with the state and federal guidelines educator evaluations are being developed and implemented throughout the district. For the upcoming school year teachers will be trained in the EBLI program. This Evidence-Based Literacy Instruction program will provide strategies that provide a systematic framework to teach research-based skills to assist all students in reaching their highest potential in reading. Sam Ewing from the Michigan Department of Education worked with the teachers on techniques on how to improve differentiated instruction and the usage of formative assessments to help monitor progress of students while meeting the state standards. North Huron Schools are encouraged and anxious to continue working with one team, one plan and one goal- high student achievement.
