**IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING GOVERNOR WHITMER'S COVID-19 UPDATE  
RELEASED AT 6:00 P.M. ON Sunday, November 15, 2020**

Dear Families,

Based on the State's requirement that high schools will not be allowed to have face to face instruction for the next three weeks beginning on Wednesday, November 17 along with the fact that North Huron has just had three days of virtual instruction, we have determined that the best course of action for our 6-12 grade students is to remain on virtual instruction beginning tomorrow, Monday, November 16. North Huron has made the decision to include 6-8 grade students in the virtual instruction because many of the secondary staff teach both jr. high and high school students and it is not possible to schedule both face to face instruction and virtual instruction effectively.

The following are items that we feel that parents and students will need to know in order for the virtual instruction to continue as smoothly as it did last week.

- 6-12 grade students will not be in the building and will receive remote instruction following the same class schedule that students followed last week.
- Parents of students in grades 6-12 who receive services through an IEP will be contacted with information regarding the continuation of the IEP services. (Special Ed classroom, speech, social work, OT, PT, TC)
- Kdg. – 5 grade students will come to school and will have a normal 7:55 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. day of instruction. This includes classes, transportation, lunch, extended day. Also students whose parents need to drop them at school by 7:30 a.m. in order to get to work on time may continue to do so.
- The Early Learning Center will be open and will follow its normal schedule.
- Food will be sent for 6-12 students for the remainder of the week on Tuesday via TAT. On Monday a google survey will be available to opt out of food delivery for those that do not want to receive the food delivery.
- Any 6-12 grade student who needs food delivery on Monday in order to have meals for the day can contact Barb at [polegab@nhuron.org](mailto:polegab@nhuron.org) or call 989-874-4101 by 9:30 a.m.
- Any 6-12 grade student who does not have internet access in order to participate in virtual instruction or has an issue with their chromebook should contact either Robin Phillips at [phillirs@nhuron.org](mailto:phillirs@nhuron.org) or Barb Polega at [polegab@nhuron.org](mailto:polegab@nhuron.org)
- Look for an announcement from Mr. Knoblock regarding whether or not there will be sports practices for the next three weeks based on MHSAA recommendations.
- TAT will be running the normal routes – efforts are being made to eliminate stops at households that have only 6-12 riders.
